Theses must not exceed 2 full pages, including figures and tables. Theses should not exceed 2 full pages, including figures, tables and references.

Text structure:

• UDC index in the upper left corner;

• thesis title (center alignment, capital letters, bold);

• name, surname of the author(s), place of work/study, e-mail address, right alignment);

• main part of thesis text (width alignment);

• references must be drown up in accordance with DSTU 8302:2015 or the APA standard.

The name of the file must contain the surname of the first author in English: (Author_Article.doc).

The organizing committee reserves the right to select materials. Co-authored theses are allowed (no more than 5 authors per 1 thesis).

Thesis sent after the specified deadline will not be considered.

The authors are responsible for the content and 1 of the submitted materials.
